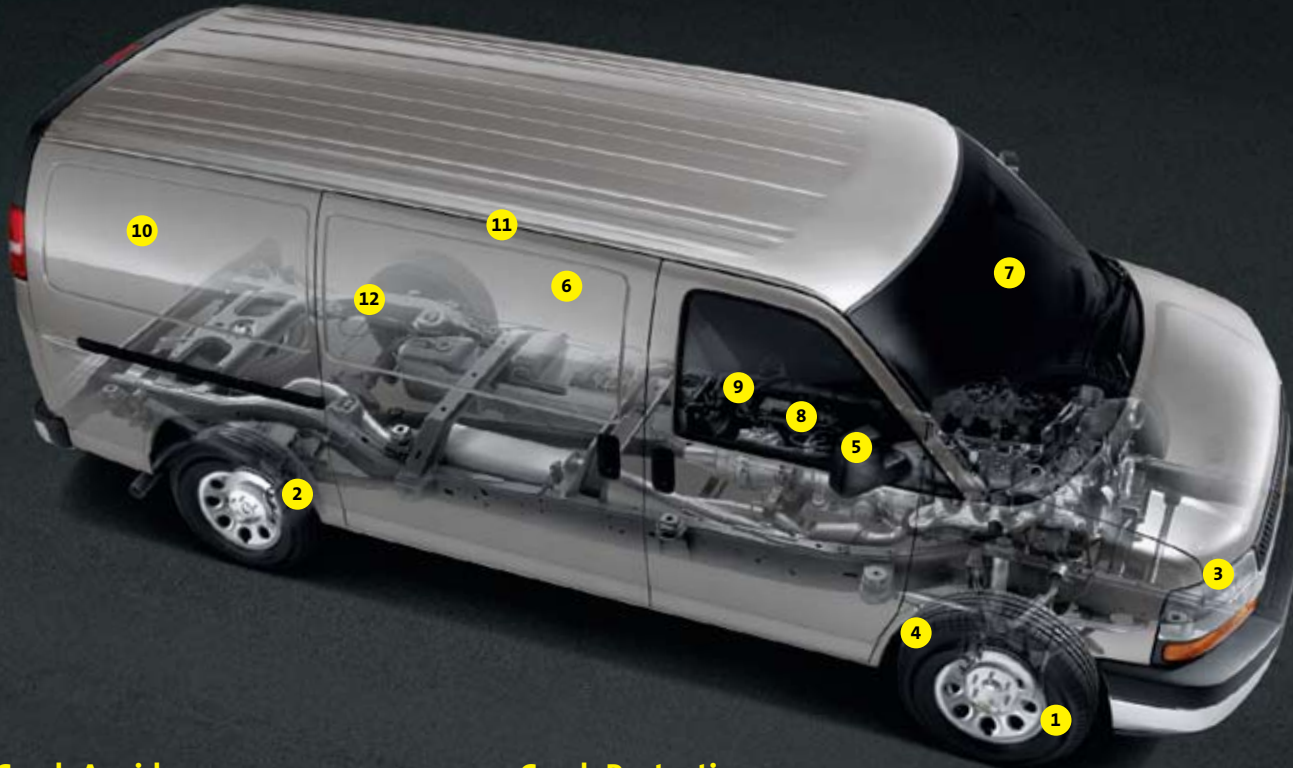

### Crash Avoidance

#### 1 StabiliTrak Electronic Stability Control System<sup>1</sup>

Designed to monitor numerous factors, such as steering angle, and automatically intervene when the system senses the vehicle is not adequately responding to driver input.

#### 2 Four-Wheel Antilock Brake System (ABS)

ABS helps the driver maintain steering control during hard braking situations.

#### 3 Daytime Running Lamps

Automatically light up on ignition for greater visibility of your vehicle by others motorists.

#### 4 Tire Pressure Monitoring System<sup>2</sup>

If a tire is overinflated or underinflated, the system will notify the driver.

#### 5 Side-View Convex Mirrors

Offer drivers a better rear field of view.

### Crash Protection

#### 6 Head-Curtain Side Air Bags<sup>3</sup>

GM segment-exclusive standard head-curtain side air bags help reduce the risk of injury to outboard occupants in certain types of side collisions and rollovers.

#### 7 Dual Front Air Bags<sup>3</sup>

Help reduce injuries to the driver and front passenger in the event of a frontal collision.

#### 8 Passenger Sensing System<sup>3</sup>

Standard on 1/2-ton models,<sup>4</sup> this feature deactivates air bags for smaller passengers, preventing air bag-induced injuries.

#### 9 Front Safety Belt Pretensioners<sup>3</sup>

Standard on 1/2-ton models, pretensioners help reduce slack in the safety belt in the event of a crash.

#### 10 Enhanced-Technology Glass<sup>4</sup>

Standard in the rear-most side windows of 12- and 15-passenger vans,<sup>5</sup> this three-layer special glass is designed to help reduce the risk of ejection during a crash.

#### 11 Steel Safety Cage

Reinforcing the floor, body sills, and roof pillars, the safety cage surrounds and protects the entire passenger compartment.

#### 12 Three-Point Safety Belts and LATCH System

Three-point safety belts are standard in every seating position. A unique LATCH harness system also makes it easy to install child safety seats in different positions throughout the van.
